A student driver who wishes to park in Mercy's parking lot must adhere to the following:

1. Park in areas designated for students, the main Gallery lot. Do not park in the faculty lot or in any of the Spirit Gala 'reserved spots.'
2. Pay a \$30 parking fee and obtain a Mercy parking tag from Ms. Whipple.
3. Display the Mercy parking pass (hang tag) on the rear view mirror.
4. Lock car.

In addition:

1. Students may not return to their car during the day without permission and a pass from an administrator.
2. If all parking spaces are taken, you must find a legal parking spot off campus. A parking pass does not guarantee a parking spot although every effort is made not to oversell parking passes. However, visitors for meetings held during the school day will also need to use the parking lot. Give yourself plenty of time in the morning to find a parking spot.
3. You may not park on the lawn, in visitor or handicapped areas, or along the driveways. You may not triple park.

Any student violating any of the above regulations will be denied the privilege of driving to school. No refunds.

Any car without a school-issued parking pass is illegally parked and may be towed from the area at the student's expense. All towed vehicles will be taken to East Avenue Auto, 1656 East Avenue.
