



Senior Privilege Permission Form 2022-2023

Dear Mercy Seniors and Parents,

Your daughter has the opportunity to take part in Senior Privileges for the 2022-2023 school year. Senior Privileges are scheduled to begin on Monday, September 12, 2022 provided this form has been signed and returned before that date. Privileges are for seniors in good standing. The following comes from the *Student Handbook 2021-2022*, section 2.05:

In order for a student to be granted senior privileges, she must be in good standing (i.e. not be on Academic or Disciplinary Probation - Sections 1.03 and 2.04) and:

- Carry a full academic program,
- Not have more than five unexcused tardies per quarter,
- Respect and comply with the rules and regulations of OLM,
- Have no outstanding detentions.

The following are available senior privileges:

- **Late Arrival** - may report late to school if she has a study hall the first period of the day. Seniors with two study halls back to back in the morning must arrive no later than 9:55 a.m. to attend Advisement. On Wednesdays, students must arrive on-time for Advisement no later than 9:45 a.m.
- **Early Dismissal Privilege** - may leave at the beginning of the third lunch block if she has a study hall scheduled during her last two classes of the day or before the start time of her single study hall scheduled during her last class of the day. Seniors must report to the Attendance Office and sign-out before leaving. **Seniors may not leave the building when they are in a sports season on days of practice/games. They must remain on campus and therefore remain in the study hall/senior lounge room.**
- **Senior Sweatshirt** - may be worn over a polo as approved by Ms. Whipple.
- **Senior Lounge** - may report to the designated senior lounge during lunch or a study hall. Must report first to the assigned study hall room to sign-out with the teacher before reporting to lounge.
- **Order Out** - may order out lunch on Fridays starting the second quarter. May eat outside in the senior courtyard, weather permitting.

The following guidelines must also be observed in reference to Senior Privileges:

- Students are responsible and accountable for any announcements or messages missed because of early dismissal/late arrival privileges.
- Students may not use early dismissal/late arrival privilege on assembly days (including liturgies).
