



TRANSPORTATION GUIDELINES

Our Lady of Mercy School for Young Women does not provide its own transportation for students.

Transportation is provided for students attending private and parochial schools no more than 15 miles from the child's home driveway to the school driveway by the district in which you reside. New request forms must be filed every year. New families must file such requests within 30 days of moving into the district.

Students in need of transportation must do the following:

- Register your daughter with the school district in which you reside.
- Obtain a transportation form directly from your school district's office or web-site.
- Fill-out and send in the form to your district; do **not** return the form to Mercy.
 - NOTE! Only Fairport and Greece require a school administrator's signature.
- Please note... most forms are due in the month of April for the next school year. Be sure to check the due date on your specific district's form.
- Districts will provide communication with bus schedules in late August.

Most districts do not provide transportation to and from Mercy when the district is not in session based on their calendar or weather closings. It is the parent's responsibility to provide transportation when busing is not available.
